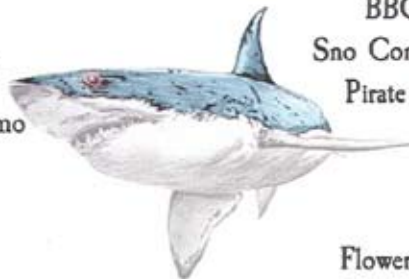

Frank and Lynn Garcia, and their daughters Katherine and Lauren who, (with Tanimura & Antle) have been the main sponsor of Carnival's Produce Market since 1999. Frank joined Tanimura & Antle 24 years ago and became acquainted with the company's long time commitment of giving back to the community, including to the Lower School Carnival. Ten years ago Frank first was introduced to Carnival when a grower for T & A, Mike Mueller, father of a former student, would come by the facility for donations for the produce stand. When, in 1999, Frank and Lynn's oldest daughter Katherine entered kindergarten, Frank volunteered to help with the booth. Eventually, Mike passed the baton to Frank and he has held it ever since.

Every year the produce that Frank has brought to Carnival has been superb. In addition to the wonderfully fresh vegetables he regularly brings, he also looks for unique items not usually on the average daily menu, including chard and snow-peas. This year he also plans on offering mache (a European style green), mini-watermelons, fresh beets, sliced packaged apples and, for the first time, radicchio. Frank will have a refrigerated bobtail on hand for those who wish to shop early and store their selection while they enjoy Carnival with their families. Follow Frank's advice, shop early, and pick up your purchase when you are ready to leave.

## BIG SUR INTERNATIONAL MARATHON

Thank you to all who participated in the Big Sur International Marathon this past Sunday, April 29. The event was well attended by our Lower School families who either ran, walked, or volunteered on the course. The 22nd BSIM was held under foggy but cooling skies, which was to the advantage of the participants. The energy was high as over 1,000 participants began the 5K, and that energy was sustained throughout the run/walk.

From our Lower School faculty, Coach Jeff Hrepich ran a 7 mile leg of the relay (which included the the 2 mile ascent of Hurricane Point), Mrs. Lorna Monroe walked/ran the 10.6 miles from Rocky Point, and Mr. Tom Schmottlach ran the 26.2 miles of the marathon in 3:29, beating the record of 3:30 that he had set for himself. Ryan Schumacher, one of our Grade 8 students, came in 1st in his age group (12-14), running the 5K in 19:10. During morning assembly on Monday, the three teachers served as wonderful role models whose united message to the students was to continue to challenge themselves, that the body is an amazing machine, and that this is one sport that they can do by themselves for a lifetime of good health.

If you were not able to join us this year, we look forward to seeing you on the course next year.
