Position Description

The Teacher Assistant is responsible for supervising students, assisting with lesson planning, preparing lesson materials, and maintaining classroom tidiness. This role aids in preparing, constructing, and maintaining materials for the classroom. The successful candidate must enjoy working with children and be devoted to building a nurturing and safe learning environment.

- Help prepare classrooms during faculty work week prior to the opening of school
- Complete all year-end responsibilities before leaving for summer vacation
- Assist with small group language arts or math activities under the teacher's supervision
- Assist individual children with following directions and be available on an individual basis for academic and emotional support
- Assume responsibility for recess and lunch duties on a regularly scheduled basis and occasionally cover teachers when circumstances require their help
- Oversee students during non-classroom times, including between classes, during lunch recess, and field trips
- Actively participate in all class activities
- Interact with both parents and children
- Attend the following school functions outside of the normal work day:

 - o Carnival
 - o Spring Concert
 - o Graduation

- Pursue professional development to maintain expertise in performance of teaching responsibilities and promote the sharing of best practices with other members of the school's faculty community
- Show genuine concern for students; demonstrate deep investment in student learning and success both in and out of the classroom
- Manage student behavior in and out of the classroom by enforcing rules and procedures
- Participate in and support the life of the school through various duties as assigned
